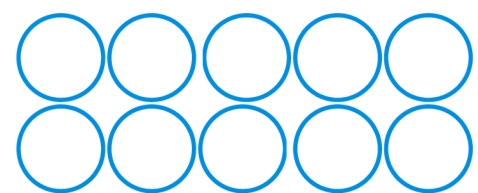

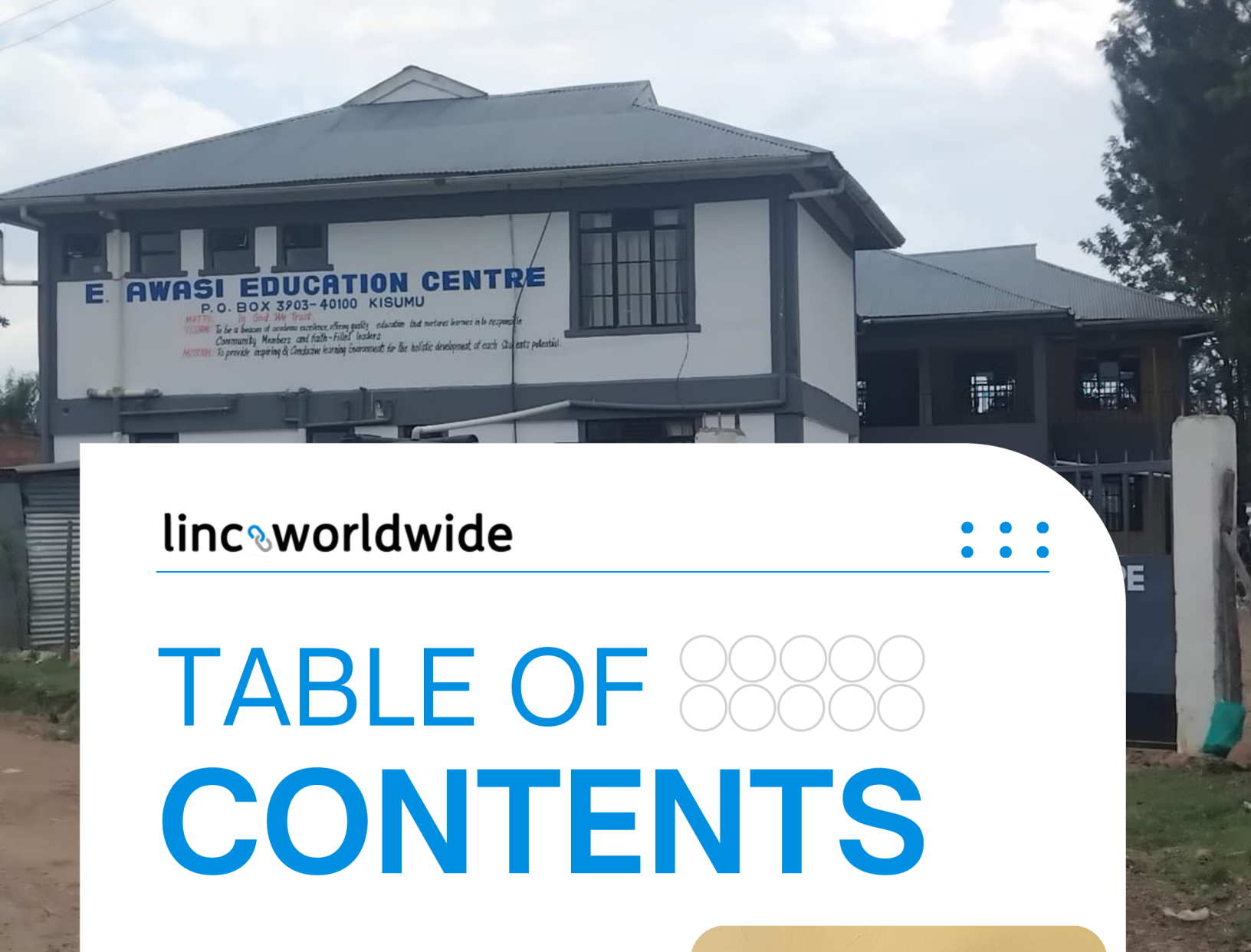

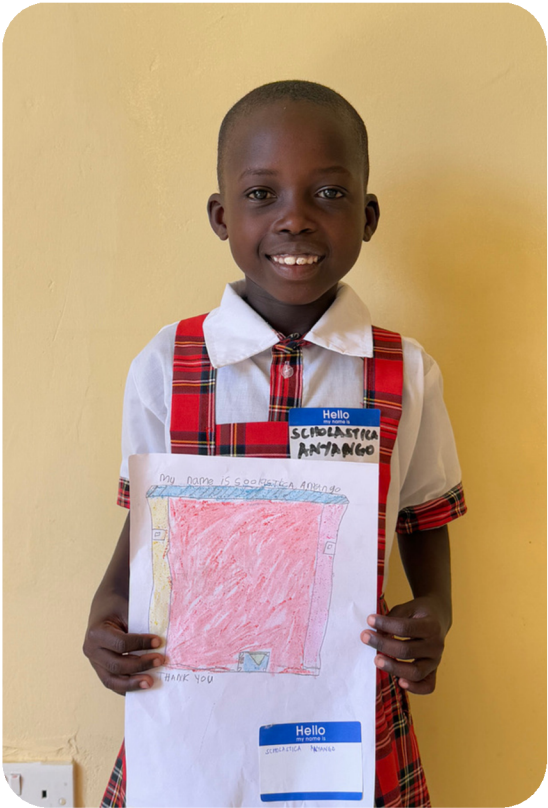

Message from the Founder & CEO



Dear LINC Supporters,

We are extremely grateful to our donors, volunteers, and supporters who enable Linc Worldwide to positively impact the lives of those in need.

Thank you for helping fulfill our mission to provide neglected communities with the support needed to alleviate hardships, promote well-being, and facilitate growth, giving them the chance to not only survive, but to truly live, love, and thrive.



January 2025 marked a monumental milestone for our team as we opened the doors of the Awasi Education Centre in Kenya. 61 orphaned and vulnerable children were enrolled for this first school year. This past year was a learning experience for our teams in the U.S. and in Kenya. We had two learners leave the school for personal reasons, two learners transfer to schools for children with special needs, three learners experience the death of a parent, and several learners require medical treatment. Together, we were able to meet the unique needs of these students.

Despite these challenges, last year was also full of moments of joy and celebration. We witnessed our students learn, grow in confidence, literacy, and creativity. The students who 'graduated' from their first year at the Awasi Education Centre returned for another year in January 2026. Through the dedicated supporters of our Child Sponsorship Program, we were able to enroll an additional 43 students for this school year. There are currently 99 sponsored students from preschool through third grade at the Awasi Education Centre. The two learners who transferred to receive special education continue to be sponsored through our program as well.

This annual report highlights our partnerships and collective successes over the past year. We hope you enjoy learning more about our organization, realize the importance of your support, and recognize the positive impact YOU have made in the lives of the communities we serve. Together, we will continue to provide communities with five core resources that meet the needs of basic survival and self-fulfillment – clean water, sustainable food sources, health & sanitation, education, safety & security.

In January 2025 we finalized construction to open the school doors of the Awasi Education Centre. This faith based primary school in Awasi, Kenya to benefit orphaned and vulnerable children. We enrolled 61 students (40 male and 21 female) for the 2025 school year (January - October 2025) from preschool through 2nd grade. 58 students completed the year at our school. 2 relocated and 1 transferred to a school for children with special needs.

We connected to a nearby well to provide temporary water for our students and staff while we prepare to drill our own well, which will ensure our school will always have clean, running water.

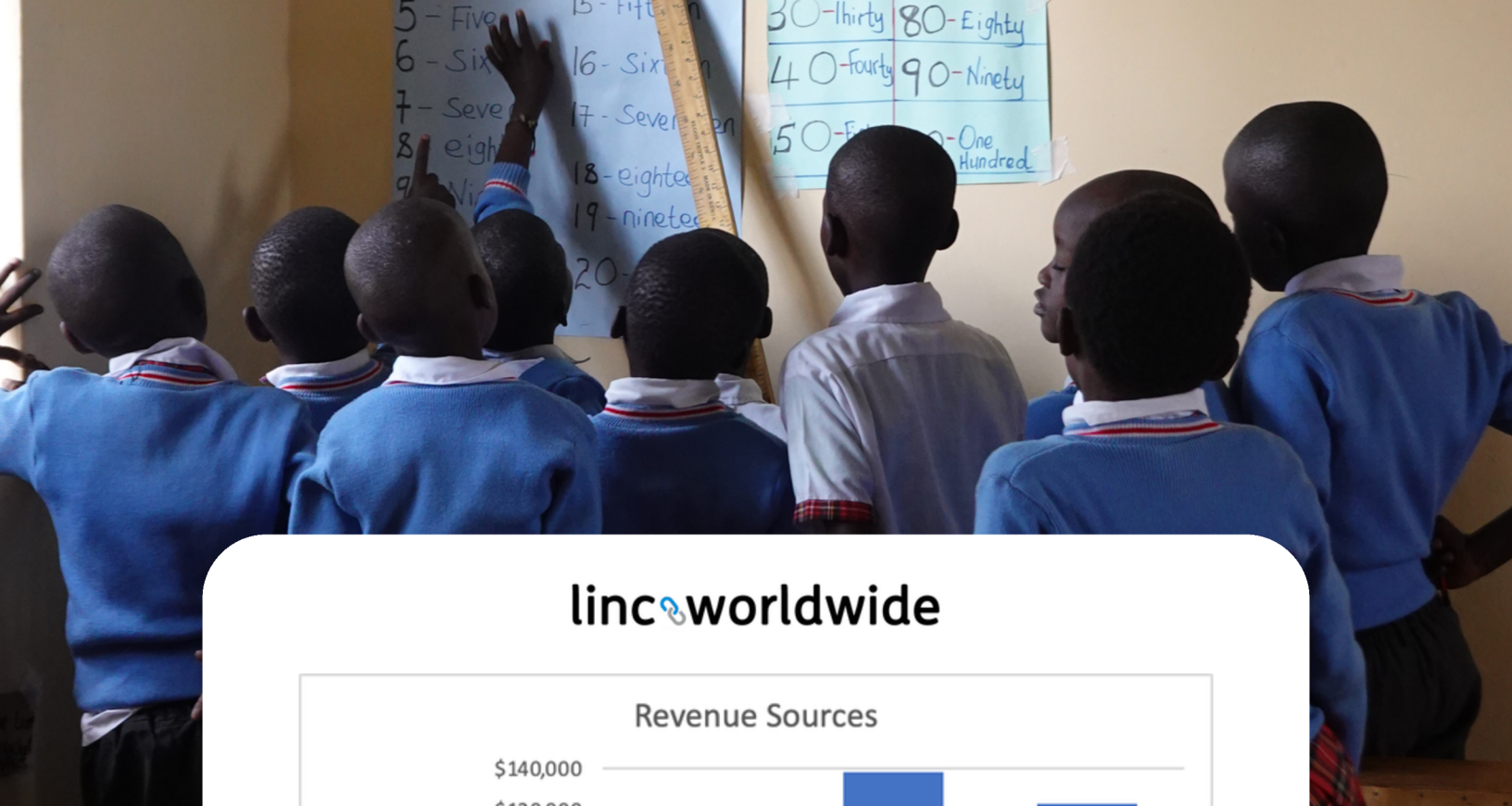

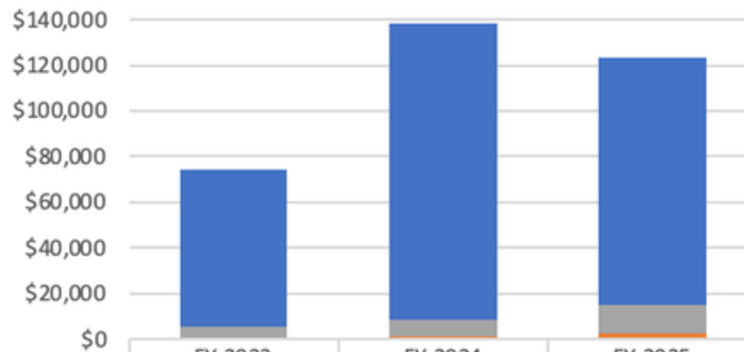

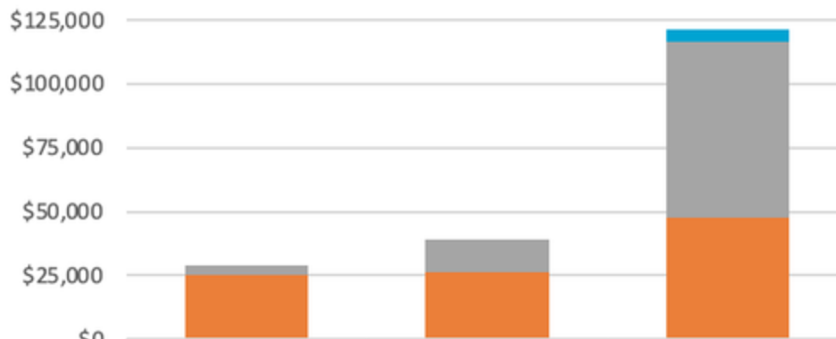

2026 School Year

- We have 101 students (54 male and 47 female) sponsored through our Child Sponsorship Program. 99 students are enrolled at the Awasi Education Centre and 2 students are attending schools for children with special needs.
- Currently employ 21 teaching and non-teaching staff

2026 School Improvements

- Purchase a school van to assist in transporting our students, especially during the rainy season when significant rainfall makes it difficult for our young students to walk to school.
- Drill a well and install solar panel powered pumps to provide clean, running water for our students and the surrounding community.

2027 Child Sponsorship Program

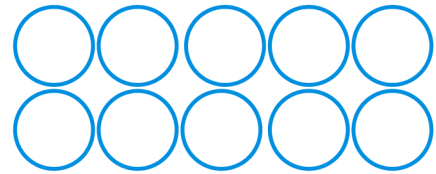
