We purchased additional land for our students to use as a playground and for space for our Clean Water Project. We are working with drilling companies with hopes to drill our well and install solar panel powered pumps in 2026!

CHILD SPONSOR CAMPAIGN



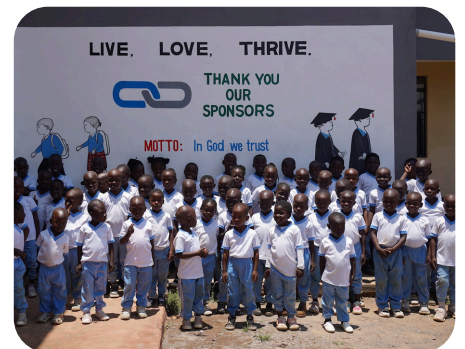

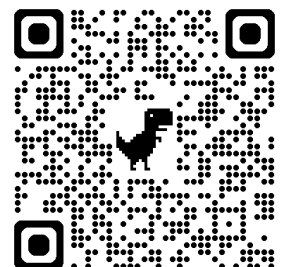
